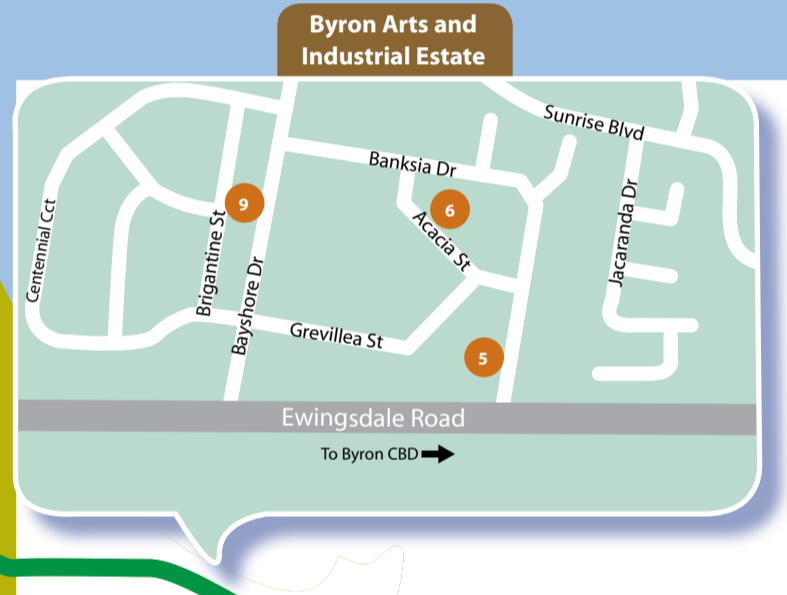




Free range eggs

Free range eggs come from poultry that are allowed to move freely within the farmyard, rather than kept in battery-style cages. Currently, there are no legally enforceable standards for the production of free range eggs in Australia, which can result in misleading claims.



Organic

Organic agriculture is an ecologically-based approach to farming that avoids the use of synthetic fertilisers and pesticides which can harm the environment and human health. Certified organic means an independent organisation has verified that the products meet organic standards.



Local food

Byron Shire is situated within a fertile agricultural region that produces an abundance of food products. Buying local food strengthens regional economies, preserves the rural landscape, reduces food miles and fosters community. Local food can be readily sourced from farmers markets, independent retailers, community gardens, food co-operatives or your own backyard!

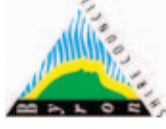
